Step 3

Step 1: Use clean urine cup to collect at <u>least 60mL</u> or more of urine sample and label container with patient's first name/last name/DOB

Step 2: Transfer 60mL of urine sample into the 30mL CytoLyte fixative container and label CytoLyte fixative container with patient's first name/last name/DOB (CytoLyte fixative container has capacity of 120mL and contains 30mL of CytoLyte solution)

If a CytoLyte fixative container is not available urine sample can be submitted in urine collection container

Step 3: Package CytoLyte fixative container for transport to Laboratory

Urine specimen collection priority if patient has multiple orders

- 1. Yellow top urinalysis tube
- 2. Grey top urine culture tube
- 3. CytoLyte fixative container

Specimen containers not acceptable for Urine Cytology
